



2018 Junior & Senior Minimoto British Championship Rules & Regulations

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION OF A MINIMOTO or MIDIMOTO

Chassis design to be within normally accepted manufacturers dimensions & Wheel Size: 6.5 inches.
Independently operated front & rear brakes, cable, or hydraulically operated if as original manufacture.

JUNIOR MINIMOTO BRITISH CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Jnr. AC40 Rookie: (Minimum age 6 years - Maximum age 13 years)

Run as one class with one set of results and trophies but NEW RIDERS MUST WEAR a Hi-Viz bib while on track (this will include the optional Friday practice days) until such time as FAB-Racing advises them they can ride without. These bibs will be available to purchase at the meetings. If a new rider with previous experience wishes to enter this class FAB will decide if they are Rookie level during practice or should move to the AC40 PRO class. Rookie riders will not be allowed to enter any additional class.

Riders that competed in the FAB-Racing Rookie class in 2017 or previously and finished in the top 6 in the Championship will not be allowed to compete in this class, they must enter the AC40 PRO class. FAB-Racing also reserves the right to require lower placed finishers in the Championship to also move up to the AC40 PRO class.

Other Riders from the Rookie class may choose to move up to the Pro class should they want and have the ability but cannot then revert back once started in the class unless FAB-Racing requires them to do so.

Motor - Air Cooled 40cc 2 Stroke:

Standard machines only.

A FAB-Racing 10mm restrictor MUST be fitted between the exhaust and cylinder. Restrictor available direct from Minimoto Racing. This must be attached to the machine with a FAB-Racing seal that must be fitted at a cost of £3.50.

Dellorto SHA14/14 or 15mm carb with NO modification.

Any off the shelf exhaust permitted except "SUPER" pipes. Hydraulic brakes permitted. These must be a kit manufactured for that bike or factory fitted. NO custom fits.

Jnr. AC40 PRO Class: (Minimum age 6 years - Maximum age 13 years)

Machine regulations as above but with 14mm Restrictor. Restrictor available direct from Minimoto Racing. This must be attached to the machine with a FAB-Racing seal that must be fitted at a cost of £3.50.

Riders in the class that do not have an LC40 Elite Minimoto can also enter the class below as an additional class on their AC40 PRO Class Minimoto with or without the restrictor removed. There would be no separation of the 2 types in the results.

Jnr. LC40 Elite: (Minimum age 7 years - Maximum age 13 years)

Motor - Liquid Cooled 40cc 2 Stroke (Air cooled machines will be permitted to race)

Std.machines only.

Dellorto SHA14/14 or 15mm carb with NO modification.

Any off the shelf exhaust permitted except "SUPER" pipes. Hydraulic brakes permitted. These must be a kit manufactured for that bike or factory fitted. NO custom fits.

Tap or distilled water only for liquid cooled motors. No additives.

NOTE FOR ALL JUNIOR CLASSES: NO MATERIAL TO BE REMOVED FROM THE CYLINDER, CYLINDER HEAD, OR CHANGES TO PORT TIMING / SHAPE UNLESS PERMITTED BY FAB ON OLDER LOWER POWERED MODELS.

2018 SENIOR Minimoto British Championship Rules & Regulations

Snr. OPEN 40 (Minimum age 14 Years)

Motor - Air or Liquid Cooled 40cc 2 Stroke:

Maximum Carb size 15mm carb for IAME Motors.

Maximum Carb size for all others 18mm.

OR

4 stroke Motor- Up to 107cc 2 valve single cylinder

Maximum Carburettor size 26mm.

Hydraulic brakes permitted, factory kit, or custom fit.

ALL CLASSES:

TYRES: ANY 6.5" TYRES

SPARK PLUGS: Must be resistor type. Eg. NGK BR8ES, BR8EIX, or etc.

MAX ENGINE SIZES IN ALL CLASSES MUST NOT BE EXCEEDED EVEN BY VERY SMALL AMOUNTS.

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOU READ AND TAKE NOTE OF THE GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT OPERATE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THESE CLASS REGULATIONS
