2019 MotoTeam British Championship Regulations

For 2019 MotoTeam will again continue to run within the Cool FAB-Racing British Championship series. The usual format at each weekend event will be 1 Practice, 2 Qualifying sessions, and 1 race on the Saturday & warm up session and 2 races on the Sunday. All 3 races will count for overall points and for Championship points. MotoTeam will run as a single class but we have retained the class 1 to 3 regulations on hand just in case it becomes possible in the future to once again run meetings mainly, or even exclusively, for MotoTeam.

NOTE: MotoTeam bikes are eligible to enter the PB-Open Class at the additional class cost of £55. Points scored in that race will not count for MotoTeam weekend or Championship points but will be scored towards PB-Open positions.

Queries on rule interpretation will be decided by FAB-Racing. There will be no restriction on engine modifications other than those laid out in the Class specifications below: -

NOTE ALL CLASSES:

- 1. SINGLE CYLINDER MACHINES ONLY.**
- 2. NO FUEL INJECTION EXCEPT SEE "C" BELOW**
- 3. NO RESTRICTION ON TYRES - SLICKS PERMITTED.**

Allowable Machines:

- A. Liquid-cooled 2 strokes up to a maximum engine capacity of 55cc. No restriction on Carburettor size. Any suitable Chassis may be used. Maximum wheel size 17". Minimum wheel size 12"
- B. Pitbikes up to 128cc Chinese manufactured only. Max wheel size 12"
- C. Pitbike motors up to 128cc mounted in Production Road Based Chassis will be accepted. Maximum wheel size 17". Minimum wheel size 12"
- C. Air or Liquid Cooled 4 strokes (2 or 4 valve) originally designed for general road use up to a maximum engine capacity of 128cc with multi speed gearbox and manual clutch. Carburettor models must have a 22mm carb or 22mm diameter inlet restrictor fitted between the carburettor and the cylinder head. Fuel Injected models must use the unmodified original injector system that was fitted as standard to the respective model. Production Road Based Chassis only. Maximum Wheel size 18".

The following modifications are permitted: -

- 1) The frame may be braced.
- 2) The suspension may be changed.
- 3) The wheel / rim sizes may be changed with a maximum of 17" and a Minimum of 12".
